### Experience the 2019 Wisconsin State Fair, West Allis, Wisconsin

Participate in the 2019 Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp program by applying to become a member of the State Fair Camp Counselor Team. Explore the fascinating fun and fast-paced inner workings of State Fair while developing and demonstrating leadership, organizational, communication and mentoring skills.

**Selection Procedure:** Youth (9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> grade) are invited to apply for a leadership role on the 2019 Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp Counselor Team. Applications including a reference must be submitted to Wisconsin State Fair ASAP. Fair Camp Management will select up to twenty-four (24) counselors (12 male and 12 female). Preference will be given to youth who have previously served as Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp Counselors. All applicants will be notified of their acceptance status.

### **Criteria for Selection:**

- 1. Entering 9<sup>th</sup> through 13<sup>th</sup> grade.
- 2. Complete and submit the application to Wisconsin State Fair ASAP.
- 3. Possess strong verbal communication, leadership skills and enjoy small group interaction.
- 4. Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp or other Camp Counselor experience.

### Roles/Duties - Day Camp Counselors are required to:

- 1. Participate in a mandatory face-to-face counselor training workshop on Thursday, August 1, 2019 from 3 to 7 pm.
- 2. Participate in both Wisconsin State Fair Day Camps: Friday, August 2 and Saturday August 3, 2019
- 3. Plan and lead at least one icebreaker/game per camp.
- 4. Supervise and be a mentoring resource for assigned campers (2<sup>nd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade) through the day's activities.
- 5. Form an adult/youth partnership with Day Camp Coordinator to assist with the program.

**Program Details:** Selected counselors will provide leadership and perform duties for the Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp, during the 2019 Wisconsin State Fair in West Allis, WI. There are no fees required; complimentary lodging (same gender rooms with bunk beds) will be provided for Thursday night. Counselors will also receive meals in the Youth Center Thursday evening through Friday evening. Counselors will work alongside similar-aged youth to assist day campers with a memorable Wisconsin State Fair Camp experience. Counselors will spend most of their time under the direct supervision of Wisconsin State Fair Day Camp Staff, adult 4-H volunteers and other Fair Camp supporters. Camp activities will include a: visit to Exploration Park, tour of Discovery Barnyard and a Giant Slide ride. Activities may also include large group games, crafting, public speaking, and performing camp songs.
